The First 4C Chain of Custody Certificate is Issued in Vietnam

In 2020, 4C launched 4C Chain of Custody (CoC) certification with the aim to **improve transparency and traceability of the coffee supply chains**. The 4C CoC certification is designed for Intermediary and Final Buyers of 4C certified coffee beans and applied on a voluntary basis. The benefits of getting 4C CoC certified include among other **supporting of sustainability claims and reduction of reputational risks**, as well as **compliance with increasing sustainability and legal requirements towards due diligence** in companies' supply chains.
