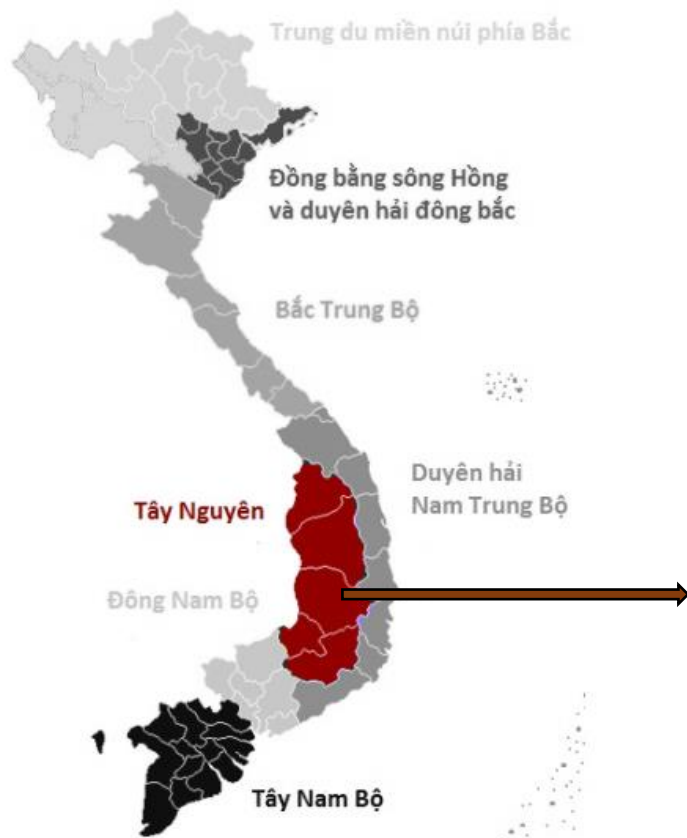

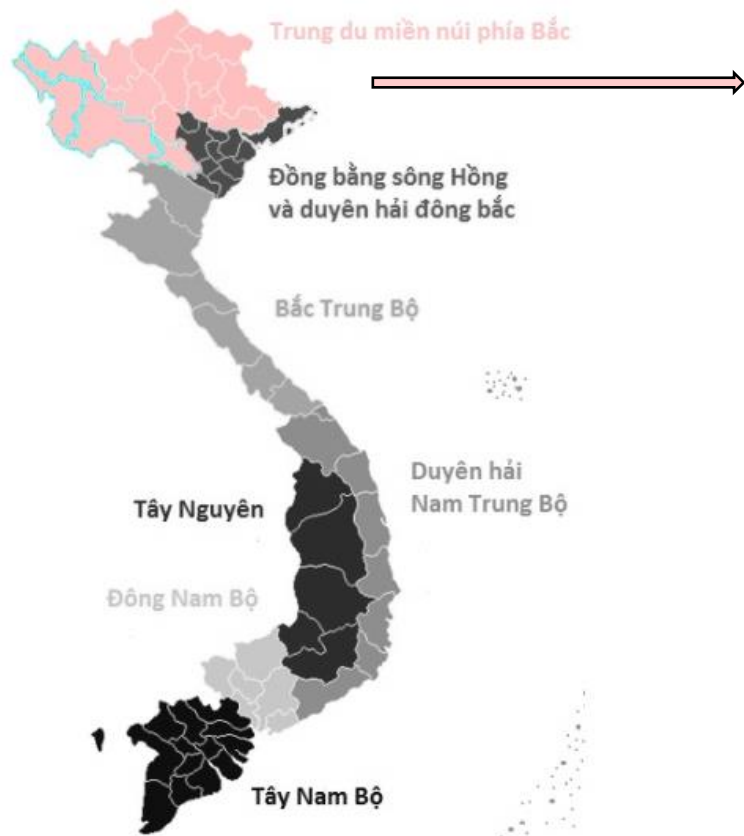
AREA, PRODUCTIVITY AND PRODUCTION OF HIGHLANDS COFFEE

Output: 1.74 million tons (95.2%)



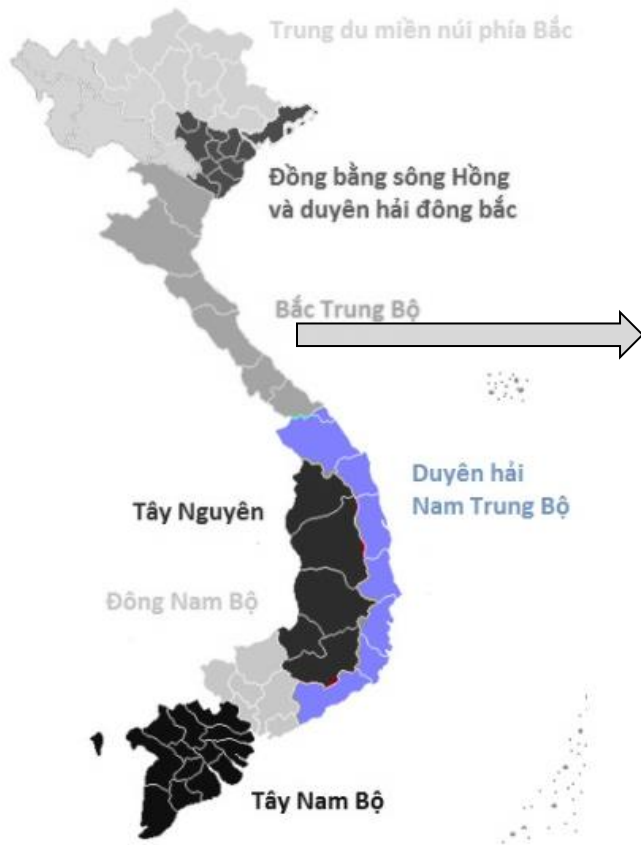
AREA, PRODUCTIVITY AND PRODUCTION OF NORTHERN MOUNTAIN AREA COFFEE

Volume: 33.5 thousand tons (1.8%)



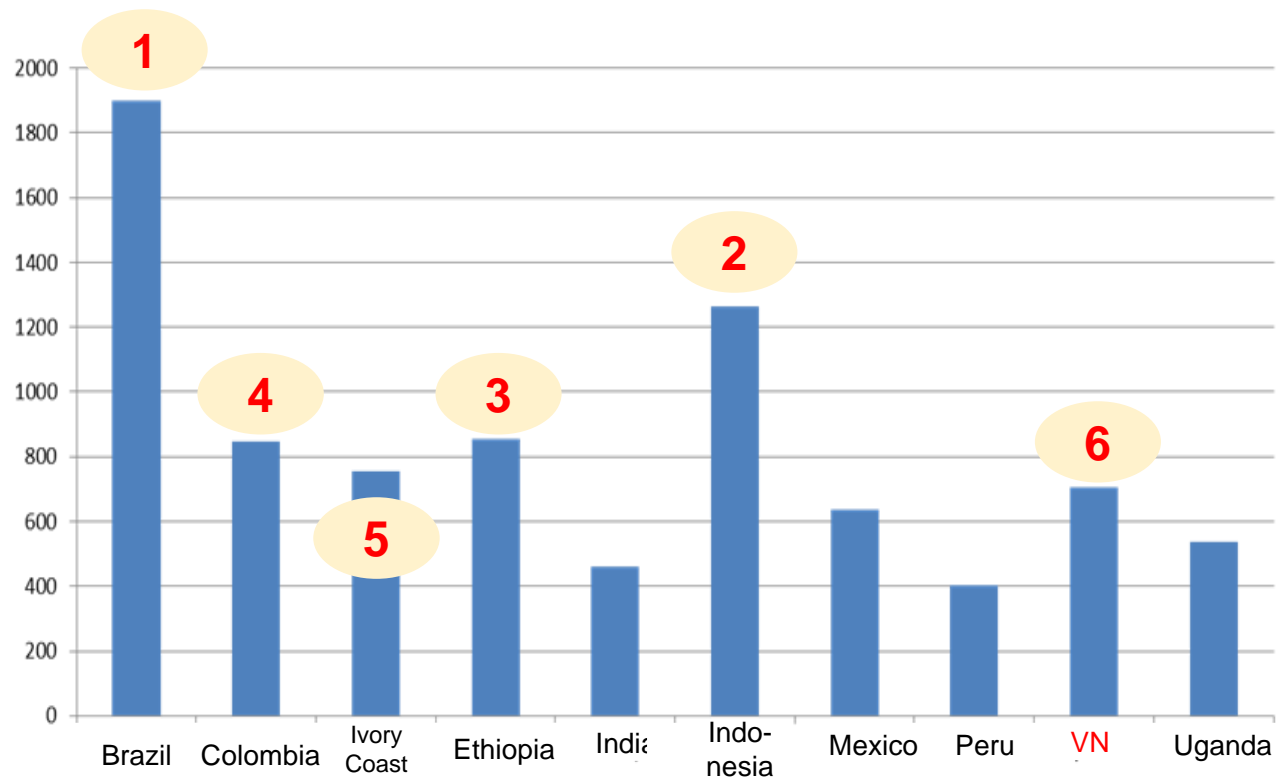
AREA, PRODUCTIVITY AND PRODUCTION OF NORTH CENTRAL COFFEE

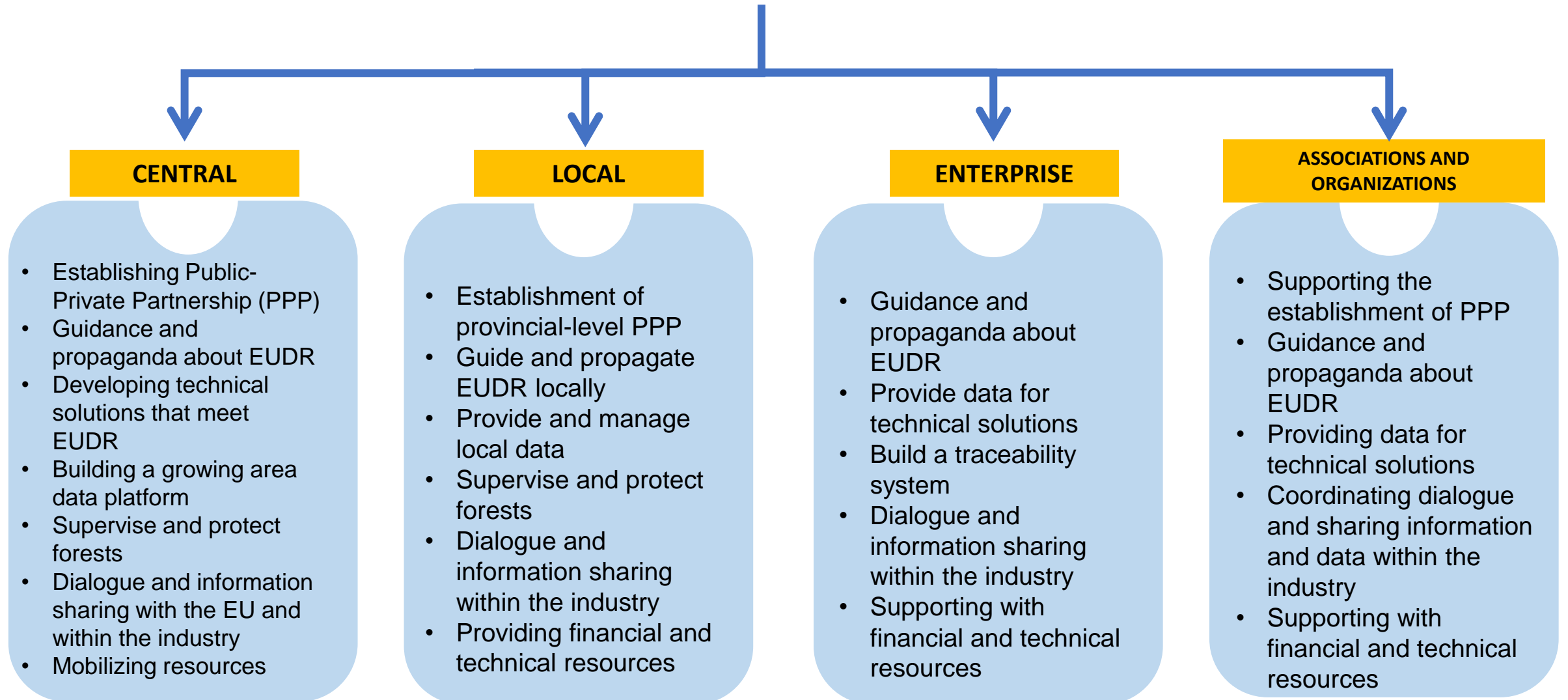
