Implement sustainable, climate-smart, productive standardized practices for agriculture and non-timber forest products and services.

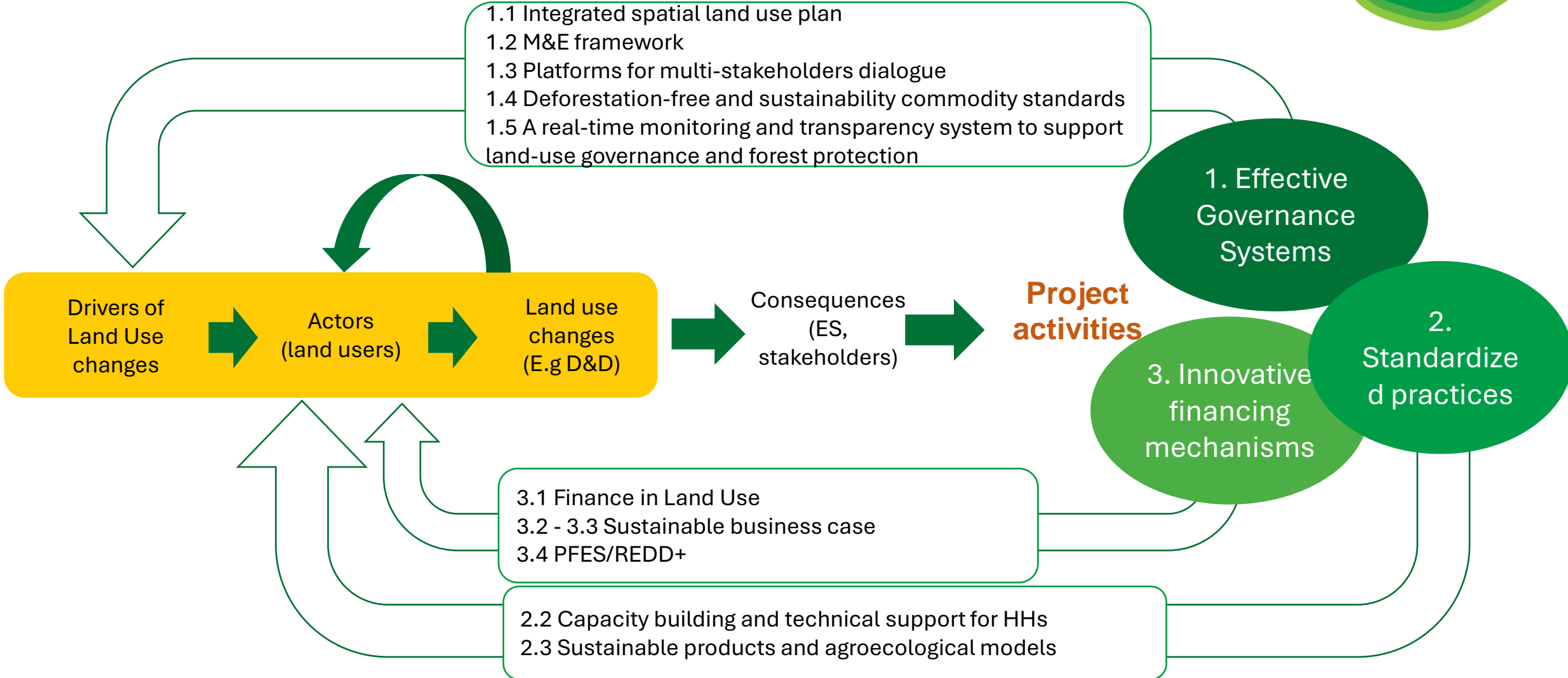
Output 3

Output 4

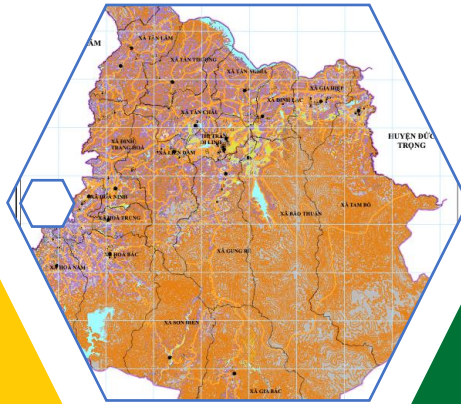
Ensure sustainability and scaling up through robust coordination, monitoring and evaluation, knowledge production and dissemination, and active advocacy at regional and national levels.

Theory of change and intergrated approach

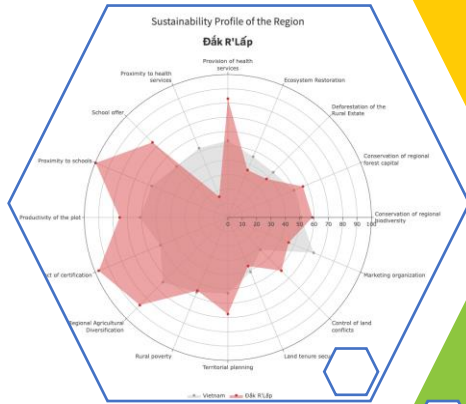


Model of land changes and feedback loops (Adopted from Hersperger et al. (2011) & van Noordwijk et al. (2011))

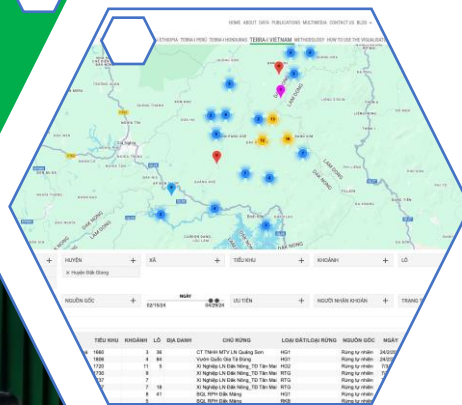

Implementing pilot interventions and supporting farmers

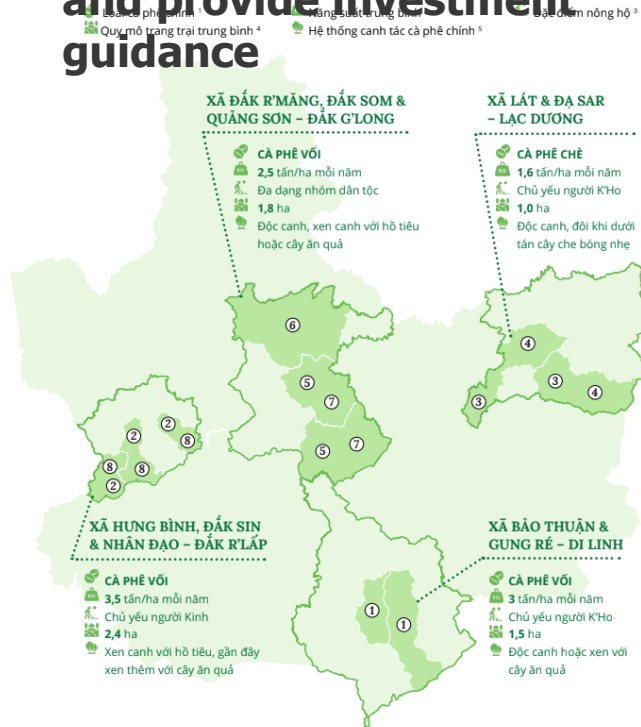


Creating sustainable livelihoods and reducing the risk of forest loss through capacity-building activities, technical support, and the implementation of sustainable models for cash crop cultivation, ecological agriculture, and non-timber forest products (NTFPs).

- **Research and identify agricultural ecological zones (AEZ)**
- **Classify agricultural models, conduct economic analysis, and provide investment guidance**

- **Develop training materials**
- **Capacity trainings for core ToT groups and farmers**

- **Pilot and scale up interventions of cash crops, agroecology, NTFPs&S**
- **for farmer groups of each AEZ**

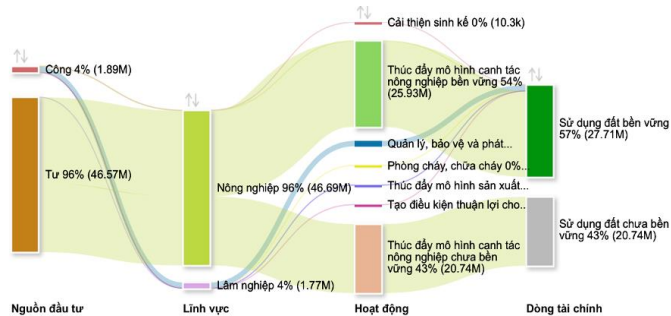


Innovative financing mechanisms
